

How did Estyn and the Wales Audit Office work together on this report? Video transcription

Our reports had a lot of areas of common interest in terms of the way the regional consortia are being led and governed, how money is being used. So the fieldwork was carried out together, in Estyn I took the lead on planning those visits, Wales Audit Office prior to the visits had a number of conversations with government officials, we pooled the evidence that we had and then went along to the each consortia and spent roughly a week in each areas working together as a team - a number of inspectors along with a number of staff from the Wales Audit Office, sharing our ideas, challenging each other, pooling our evidence, carrying out joint interviews of staff within the consortia. So it really worked well in using the different expertise that people brought to the table to feed into our respective reports.
